**Re: REMAC Paramedic Credential Extension**

**\*This memo supersedes the Paramedic Credential Extension issued in March 2020\***

The Westchester REMAC (WREMAC) is aware that most classroom based continuing medical education programs and call audits have been cancelled by sponsors for an unknown period of time. In order to address this interruption and prevent the loss of otherwise qualified Paramedics in the field, the WREMAC has granted the following WREMAC Credential Extension.

Any Paramedic WREMAC Credential that expired after **9/1/2019** will have their expiration date extended by **1 year**.

This date will match the New York State extension. A WREMAC Credential is only valid if the provider has a valid New York State issued Paramedic Certification. New York State expirations can be verified using the State Health Commerce System.

This letter, in combination with the original WREMAC card, shall serve as proof of credential. Credentials can be verified by contacting the Regional EMS office. We are working to update the online database.
