Re: NY State Patient Care Reports (PCRs)

Date: Wednesday, February 3, 2010

Back in December 2009 a memo was sent out on behalf of WREMSCO Chairman, Dan Blum in regards to the shortage of the New York State Patient Care Reports (PCRs). Since that time, New York State was able to print additional PCRs and began shipping supplies this week.

The new PCRs no longer have a tracking number printed on the forms. Instead, there is a section with the number "5" and a number of empty boxes where you can put your own tracking number.

If your Agency is in need of PCRs, please contact our office and we will arrange a date and time for pick up.

If your Agency is interested in implementing an E-PCR system, please contact our office for important information.

*Also, notification from the New York State Bureau of EMS has been received that all 2009 PCRs must be received by the end of February. As a result, agencies are asked to submit all remaining 2009 PCRs to the Regional EMS office no later than **Tuesday, February 16th.***
