- Vehicle Maintenance/mechanic work
- Grant writing
- Building maintenance (boilers, generators, LED's, etc.)
- Providing increased incentives to members of volunteer agencies
- County-level support for EMS agencies to share services
- Leverage municipal social media resources to promote EMS and EMS recruitment efforts.
